Who is Paul?

So, who is this Paul guy who wrote this letter we are reading?

Well, Paul was a friend of Jesus but before he met Jesus, he was called Saul and he was not quite so nice. In fact, he was rather horrible to anyone who was a friend of Jesus.

But one day, he had a vision of Jesus, became friends with Him and his heart was changed forever. He went from being unkind, to being kind because he realized that he was loved by Jesus.



Who is he writing to?

Paul wanted everyone to become friends with Jesus and he traveled to lots of places telling people about Jesus and starting churches for new believers. He wrote letters to these churches offering advice on how to become friends of God and how to live with God.

One of the letters he wrote was to a church in Ephesus (in modern day Turkey). In our Bibles it's called the Book of Ephesians.



Week

Ephesians 1:4


Paul starts Ephesians by introducing himself to them and reminding them of how much God loves them.

Ephesians 1:4 says:
In Christ, He chose us before the world was made. He chose us in love to be His holy people.

Pray:

Thank God for His world, and that He has chosen you and loves you.

Make the circle into a world by adding land and sea. Around the circle draw a sun, the moon and add more stars. Then color the whole picture in.



Ephesians 1:15



In his letter, Paul prays giving thanks for the people he is writing to.

Ephesians 1:15 says:

That is why I always remember you in my prayers and thank God for you.

Pray:

Who are you thankful for? Like Paul, write a prayer on the next page giving thanks for them.



Ephesians 2:10

Do you have a favorite artist? Or a favorite painting? God is known as being like an artist, He is super creative. Just look at all the different animals and plants - He created all of them! Paul says that out of all that God created, we are His favorite thing.

Ephesians 2:10 says:

We are God's masterpieces.

Pray:

Think about what you are good at and what you like about yourself. Pray and thank God for creating you like this!

Draw a self portrait. Write around it the things that you are good at, or what you like about yourself.

Ephesians 2:19

The Bible tells us how we all belong in God's family. In his letter, Paul reminds us of this...

Ephesians 2:19 says:

You belong to God' family

Popcorn Prayer:

Curl up in a small ball, on the floor. Taking turns, give a little wiggle, before 'popping up' and saying the name of someone in God's family you are thankful for.

Find a blank piece of paper. Follow the instructions to make a people-paper chain. Decorate each one as someone you love.

STEP 1:

Fold your paper over - the more folds, the more people.

STEP 2:


Draw the outline of half a person.

STEP 3:

Carefully cut around the shape - but not on the fold.

STEP 4:

Unfold the people and decorate!



Ephesians 3:12

Everyone has things that they are scared of and things they worry about. But the Bible tells us that God wants us to tell Him what we are scared of or worried about. When we tell God these things, we can ask Him to give us His peace instead.

Ephesians 3:12 says:

In Christ we come before God with freedom and without fear. We can do this because of our faith in Christ.

Pray:

With an adult, get some paper and write down your fears. Pray and tell God what they are, and then ask Him to give you His Peace. Then, crumble the fears you wrote on your paper up and throw them away as an act of faith of giving it to God.

Often, when we are scared, life feels like we're stuck in a maze. Can you find your way to the middle of the maze?





Memory Challenge

Learning Bible verses "by heart" can be so helpful to us. By heart means by memory, which is why we call them memory verses. We will have memory challenges for you to learn over the next three weeks.

Ephesians 3:18

What is the tallest thing you can think of? How about the widest, longest or deepest? Did you know that the tallest mountain in the world is Mount Everest, at 29,000 feet above sea level? In his letter, Paul tells us that God loves us so much more than that.

Ephesians 3:18 says:

And I pray that you and all God's holy people will have the power to understand the greatness of Christ's love—how wide, how long, how high, and how deep that love is.

Pray:

Find a bit of space. Stretch your arms out as wide as you can, hold that pose and breathe in for 5 seconds, breathe out for 5 seconds, as you do this, in your head say 'Thank you God for loving so widely.' Then stretch up as high as you can, breathe in for 5 seconds, breathe out for 5 seconds, in your head say 'Thank you God that your love for me is higher than this.'

Color in the page as brightly as you can.



Ephesians 4:2

Do you find it easy to wait for something? Sometimes is can be hard to be patient, but the good news is that we can pray and ask God to help us to be humble, gentle and patient.

Ephesians 4:2 says:

Always be humble and gentle. Be patient and accept each other with love.

Pray:

Set a timer for one minute.

During that time, pray about your day and the people who you will be around.

Ask God to help you to be humble, gentle and to have patience with others as you show them His love.

Ephesians 4:15

Paul says that as we spend time with Jesus (Christ), we will become more like Him. Read this list of the Fruits of the Spirit in Galatians 5:22-23 (another one of Paul's letters). This list is what Jesus is like and what we will become like.


Ephesians 4:15 says:

'We will grow to be like Christ in every way.'

Pray:

Go on a prayer walk with an adult. As you look at all the plants and trees, ask God to help you grow in the Fruits of the Spirit and become more like Jesus.

Color in the picture of the Fruits of the Spirit.



Ephesians 4:32

Sometimes, we say, think, or do unkind things to others. Saying sorry is admitting that you have done something wrong and want to make it right. The good news is that Jesus died and rose again so that we could be forgiven. When we ask God to forgive us, He always does and Paul is telling us to do the same for others.

Ephesians 4:32 says:

Be kind and loving to each other.
Forgive each other the same as God
forgave you through Christ.

Pray:

Find a stone, hold it in your hand.

As you hold it, tell God what you are sorry for and who you need to forgive. Put the stone down, and thank God for forgiving you.

Paul talks a lot about love. He understood just how much God loved him. He also understood how we can help others to understand this love by showing it to them.


Ephesians 5:12 says:

Ephesians 5:8-9 says:


So live like children who belong to the light. This light produces every kind of goodness, right living, and truth.

Think about why you love God.
Use the things that come to mind to write either a poem or worship song of praise to Him on the next page.



Ephesians 5:20


What are you thankful for?

Ephesians 5:20 says:

Always give thanks to God the Father for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Pray:

Ephesians 6:1

Did you know that the Bible says that children should obey their parents and that parents should care for and love their children?

Ephesians 6:1 says:

Children, obey your parents the way the Lord wants, because this is the right thing to do.

Pray:

Ask your parent what you can pray for them. You can follow this prayer template if you like.

Dear God, thank you for (their name), thank you that they are a part of my family.



Paul knew that we would need help to be like Jesus and so he tell us about Spiritual armor we can wear by praying each day.

Ephesians 6:14-18 says:


14 So stand strong with the belt of truth tied around your waist, and on your chest wear the protection of right living. 15 On your feet wear the Good News of peace to help you stand strong. 16 And also use the shield of faith with which you can stop all the burning arrows that come from the Evil One. 17 Accept God's salvation as your helmet. And take the sword of the Spirit—that sword is the teaching of God. 18 Pray in the Spirit at all times. Pray with all kinds of prayers, and ask for everything you need.

Pray:



Can you link each piece of the armor to the person.




The Belt of Truth



God helps me to know what is true, and helps me to speak the truth to others.


The Breastplate of Righteousness

The Shoes of the Gospel of Peace


Draw a line from one shoe to the other in order to make a matching pair.

The Shield of Faith


Complete the drawing of the shield and color it in.

The Helmet of Salvation


Color in and decorate your helmet.


