- 4. What does it look like for you to live your life with dedication and purpose?
- 5. What are some 'winning plays' that you are currently doing or would like to start that would make a difference for you?

Matthew 19:4-6

⁴ "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' ⁵ and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'? ⁶ So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate."

- 2. What are some common challenges people face in marriage? Why do you believe these challenges are universal?
- 3. From the list of Pro-tips that Scotty gave, what are a couple you would like to focus on?
- 4. What is a win in your relationship or marriage right now?
