OUR STORY 04

Our story began as a small group of believers meeting in a hotel ballroom. In 2007, we moved into an old grocery store off Holly Street and built something special, a place where people met Jesus and lives were transformed.

That group of people became Journey Church.

In 2015, we purchased 12 acres off I-25 for \$450,000. Through our first BUILD campaign, that land was paid for in cash. By 2017, we had moved into our first permanent home in Castle Pines.

What started as a small community of 500 quickly exploded in growth. By Christmas 2019, over 4,000 people packed into that little building. Then came 2020. Despite the challenges, God remained faithful. Journey resumed growing in 2021. And by 2023, it was time to build again.

And you showed up.


Through your bold generosity, we expanded Castle Pines, launched a dynamic Residency Program, and opened new locations in Parker and Lone Tree.

The result? Explosive growth in the number of people finding their hope in Jesus, hundreds of baptisms, and a movement in our Next Gen ministry that's changing everything.

Since expanding the Castle Pines building and launching both the Parker and Lone Tree locations, the growth of Journey has been exponential. When we moved to our original building in 2017 we were a church of about 500 attenders, today, around 3,000 people gather weekly at our three locations.

It's not just about the thousands of people who call our church home. It's about the stories we hear every week of lives changed, marriages being restored, and people taking their next steps with God. And it's because all along the way, every time we've asked, faithful people have taken big steps of generosity.

And now it's our turn to do it again.



The Canter family stepped through the doors of Journey almost 16 years ago and their lives haven't been the same since.

Chris grew up with no faith background, but when he met Kim, she insisted that if they were going to get married, he needed to become a Christian. So, as a young married couple with a new baby, one Sunday they were invited by friends to give Journey a try.

Immediately, upon walking in, Chris had this overwhelming feeling that this was where he needed to be and where he was going to grow with God. Right away, Chris got plugged into small groups, Bible studies, and serving in the kids ministry.

Chris said, "Months down the road, I had the epiphany that my life was truly centered around Christ." And Chris wasn't the only one who noticed the change. Kim said, "It was amazing to see Chris really become a man of God through being a part of Journey."

Years later, in a moment of crisis, after a traumatic birth of their twins at 31 weeks, Chris found himself in the hospital at risk of losing his wife and two new babies. Unsure of what to do, he turned to the men in his small group to ask for prayer. Right away, the people of Journey rallied around the Canters. Chris and Kim were overwhelmed with the support they received from their church family.

Since that time, they have continued to be involved in all areas of Journey, and their three boys are impacted weekly by the kids and student ministries at Journey. Kim said it best, "Journey offers everything our family needs to get to the next level in our faith. There is always something to challenge our faith and help us grow. Our family is ultimately centered around our Journey family."

BECAUSE OF PEOPLE.


THOUSANDS are moving into our community—many far from God. They need a spiritual home.

THE GOAL IS **\$10 MILLION** OVER 2 YEARS
TO DO WHAT?

1. PARKER BUILDING

\$8 million to establish a permanent home for our Parker location—a space that will serve the community for generations to come. The new building will include a 350-seat auditorium, dedicated kids and student environments, and space for ministry seven days a week.

2. NEXT GENERATION

We're investing **\$1 MILLION** to change the story for the next generation—providing the resources, staff, and leaders needed to reach, build, and equip 10 times more kids, students, and parents.

3. MISSIONS

We're committing **\$1 MILLION** to make a global impact—supporting the Christmas Store and launching church plants in Denver and beyond. Helping build a church in Haiti, a chapel in Uganda, and a Compassion Center in Peru that will serve families for years to come.




SOUTH-EAST ELEVATION

What are the best ways to give financially to BUILD the Future?

We encourage everyone who calls Journey Church home to pray and ask God what you should give, and then do what God says. For many, this will be through generosity above their normal, regular giving.

Are we allowed to have a church in Parker at the La-Z-Boy building location?

YES! We have the approval from the Town of Parker zoning department for occupancy and use as a church facility.

Is there enough parking, and where will we park?

YES! We have 123 off-street spaces shared with neighboring lots—exceeding the 117 required for our 350-seat capacity. Additional on-street parking is also available. A traffic study, approved by the Town of Parker, confirmed adequate traffic flow, and our Parking Team will ensure a safe and smooth experience on Sundays.

How long will construction take?

We anticipate the total remodel project to take 4–6 months. We are working with the same construction team that assisted us with our Castle Pines expansion.

Are we going to take on any debt for these projects?

The goal is that we add no additional debt for the church. This keeps money available for ministry, rather than debt service.

When will we begin holding in-person services at the NEW Parker Location?

Because of the generosity of our people, we are expecting we can begin holding in-person services in early 2026.

Is it better to give our financial gift as a one-time gift or on a recurring basis?

To make such a generational impact, it will take both for most of us. For some, this will be through one-time gifts from stored assets (cash, stocks, 401k, real estate, bitcoin, etc.), and through ongoing monthly contributions.

How long is my financial commitment?

We are asking everyone who calls Journey Church home to make a two-year commitment above and beyond their regular giving.

How will we reach more families with the \$1M investment?

We're investing \$1 million to change the story for the next generation—providing the resources, staff, and leaders needed to reach, build, and equip 10 times more kids, students, and parents.

What will we do with the \$1M of funds raised for missions?

We're committing \$1 million to make a global impact—supporting Journey Christmas Stores; launching church plants in Denver and beyond; and helping build a church in Haiti, a chapel in Uganda, and a Compassion Center in Peru that will serve families for years to come.

Does Everyone get a La-Z-Boy?
