Purpose of Role:

The Student Director is instrumental in shaping the spiritual journey of middle and high school students from grades 6th to 12th at the Journey Parker location. Their leadership guides these students through pivotal years, fostering growth, alignment with the church's vision, and meaningful relationships.

Primary Tasks

- Leads, trains, and empowers serve teams dedicated to discipleship for middle and high school students.
- Works with the Kids Ministry Pastor and Student Ministry Pastor to create seamless transitions for students and families from Kids Ministry to Student Ministry.
- Works synergistically to achieve the goals of family ministry as a whole.
- Ensures all student programs resonate with the church's mission, vision, and ethos, emphasizing discipleship growth.
- Collaborates with the Student Ministry Pastor in nurturing connections with community stakeholders such as schools and organizations for maximum ministry impact.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Serves on the church's Ministry Team, collaborating with all church staff members.
- Collaborates with the Student Ministry Pastor in budgeting, ensuring sound financial stewardship for Student Ministry programs.
- Intentionally cultivate student relationships, fostering personal and spiritual growth.
- Responsible for ministry large group teaching or finding someone to teach almost every week at Parker Student services.
- Assists in orchestrating Student Ministry leadership gatherings, training sessions, and events for both participants and serve teams.
- Prays regularly for the church and its people, and models spiritual vitality and accountability, setting an example in spiritual maturity and dedication.
- Communicates and collaborates with other staff regarding Ministry and Church issues and activities.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Supervisory Responsibilities:

- The Parker Student Director will oversee serve team members, residents, and interns committed to Student Ministry as directed by the Student Pastor.
- The Parker Student Director will seek to disciple serve team members, residents, and interns, providing leadership, guidance, support, and training to ensure effective ministry.

Experience & Education Required:

- Strong Christian character as described in 1 Timothy 3:2-7
- Proficient teaching and preaching abilities, with a flair for making spiritual topics relatable to young minds.
- Ability to work with a team to plan and execute large events and environments. Ability to ask for help, reach out, collaborate with diverse teams, etc.
- Excellent organization and multi-tasking skills. Reliable, trustworthy, and excellent at following through on details.
- Proficiency in Mac OS, Google Docs, and the ability to learn and use PCO Software.
- A Bachelor's degree in Bible/Theology, Education, adolescent/family studies, or a related field is required.
- Leadership experience in Student/Youth Ministry or a related role, preferably in a large church or organization with a weekly attendance of at least 1000.

Physical Requirements:

- Comfortable standing for extended periods during teaching or leading sessions.
- Ability to manage events, which may involve setting up equipment or moving materials.

Possess and exhibit the following core values in their daily lives:

- Personal Love for God and Love for People.
- Work ethic that is excellent, protective of the church and frugal with time and money.
- Attitude of a servant, enjoyable to be with and devoted to the call of God and the church.
- Supports the mission of Journey Church by being an active member and attender.
